This Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for premature release.

It is asserted that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by various instructions, specifically, by the policy of Premature Release dated 04.04.2013. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the State is directed to consider the case of the petitioner in terms of said policy.

Heard.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to re-examine the case of the petitioner for premature release and decide the same by passing a speaking order, expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from today, in accordance with law.
