Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced original receipt No. 75 dated 04.10.2017 showing that an amount of ₹37,500/- has been deposited with the Legal Services Committee of this Court in compliance of the order dated 18.08.2017 passed by this Court.

It comes out from the order dated 18.08.2017 passed this Court that the parties have compromised the matter and under the said compromise the respondent-complainant has received entire settled amount ₹2,50,000/-.

Since, the dispute has been amicably settled, therefore, the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 19.09.2016 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Ferozepur convicting and sentencing the petitioner to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year and to pay a fine of ₹2,000/- and in default thereof to further undergo simple imprisonment for one month as well as the judgment dated 17.05.2017 passed

by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur dismissing the appeal are hereby set aside and the petitioner is acquitted of notice of accusation served upon him. The bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner stand discharged.

In view of the above, the present revision stands allowed.
