Custody certificate filed in the Court today is taken on record.

Report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre received, in which it is stated that the parties have entered into a compromise. The victim has been paid monetary compensation. The offence committed in the present case is punishable under Section 279 and 338 IPC.

Since the offences have been compounded with the intervention of Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, therefore, the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 06.09.2016 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sangrur as well as the judgment dated 25.05.2017 passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Sangrur, are hereby set aside. The petitioner stands acquitted of the charges framed against him. Bail bonds and surety bonds stand discharged.

As such, the present revision petition is allowed.
