An unsigned complaint has been received which was converted into the criminal writ petition in the nature of Habeas Corpus.

In the said complaint, the allegations were levelled by one Dial Singh against his wife Sukhwinder Kaur and Salwinder Kaur (Wife of Sajjan Singh). The said ladies had illicit relations with Kuldeep Singh and Satnam Singh, accused No. 3 and 4 respectively. His brother Sajjan Singh is missing and said ladies are responsible for disappearance of Sajjan Singh.

Notice of motion was issued to the State. The Police has enquired into the matter. Sh. Harjit Singh, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran has filed an affidavit dated 28.02.2017, wherein he has stated that enquiry in the said matter has already been made. The statements of respectables of village have been recorded in which they have stated that the said ladies have no role in disappearance of Sajjan Singh. Even, Dial Singh made a statement before the police during investigation that he does not want to proceed with the complaint.

Today, further status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Sohan Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District

Tarn Taran, on behalf of the respondent-State, has been filed in which it is stated that Sajjan Singh was previously working in Roza MacDowell wine factory, Shahajahanpur, Uttar Pradesh and was habitual drunkard and usually absented from his work. Due to this fact, his services were discontinued by the said company in June 2015.

Therefore, it is apparent from the investigation conducted so far that no crime was committed against Sajjan Singh.

In view thereof, the present application is ordered to be filed.
