By way of present petition the petitioner has sought the release of alleged detenu(s)-Mohammad Ali and Naresh Kumar from the illegal confinement.

The learned Amicus Curiae for the petitioner states that no response has been received from the petitioner.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, states that on the complaint lodged by Gram Panchayat, Ghanauri Khurd, notices under Section 160 Cr.P.C. were issued to the alleged detenu(s), however, they did not appear as the dispute had been settled in the meantime as reflected in Annexure R-2 (Panchayati Compromise). Therefore, neither the detenu(s) were taken into custody nor illegally detained, which is further fortified from the statement of the petitioner.
