Amended memo of parties along with fresh Power of Attorney filed on behalf of Ld. counsel for the petitioner in Court today; be kept on record.

[2]. The petitioner is a juvenile, who is in custody since 06.02.2017. The allegation against the petitioner is that he had accompanied Rohit and Sagar. The pistol was, allegedly, provided by the petitioner and it was Rohit, who had fired which led to the death of Parshant, who was also a juvenile.

[3]. The social investigation report is available. The petitioner's behaviour was stated to be good and he wants to continue his studies. The petitioner's father has filed an affidavit and has undertaken that his son would not associate with any criminal activity and ensures that he would not be involved in any other case. He also states that there would not be any default and the petitioner would regularly appear before the Juvenile Justice Board.

[4]. In view of the circumstances and the allegations against the petitioner and considering the Probation Officer's report and the undertaking given by his father, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court with a condition that the petitioner would not make a single default and would regularly appear before the Court below.

[5]. The petition is disposed off.
