KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Impugned in the present revision is the judgement dated 11.07.2017 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda affirming the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 17.07.2015 of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda vide which the present petitioner was convicted for offence punishable under Section 411 of Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year and to pay fine of ₹1,000/- and in default thereof, to further under rigorous imprisonment for one month.

Learned counsel for the petitioner presses the present revision only on the point of quantum of sentence.

Custody Certificate 13.09.2017 has been filed in the Court today which shows that the petitioner has undergone actual sentence of 03 months and 12 days including remissions. It is further mentioned that the petitioner is not previous convicted in any other case nor any other case is pending against him.

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Considering the facts and circumstances of the present case, the sentence of rigorous imprisonment awarded for a period of one year under Section 411 of the Indian Penal Code is ordered to be reduced to the sentence of rigorous imprisonment for a period of six months under the said Section whereas the sentence of fine is maintained.

With the above mentioned modification in quantum of sentence, the present revision stands dismissed.
