The writ petition is filed by convict-Rahul son of Ratti Pal praying for his release on parole for 28 days to enable him to meet his family members and fulfill their needs.

Heard the submissions made on either side.

It is found that the applicant in fact submitted an application seeking the above relief before the jail authorities on 15.01.2016. As no report was received from the District Magistrate, Rai Bareilly, it appears that the application submitted by the petitioner on 15.01.2016 has not been disposed of till date by the authorities concerned.

During the pendency of the writ petition, the District Magistrate, Rai Bareilly (UP)-3rd respondent herein, has submitted his report. 1st respondent has also received the copy thereof.
