The petitioner has approached this Court with following
multifold reliefs, which reads as under:-

*“Civil Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the
Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, direction or
order directing an investigation from an independent
agency into the ghastly incident wherein a convict serving
life sentence in a murder case wherein five persons were
brutally killed and who in connivance with the Punjab
Police Officials has been made to escape from judicial
custody,*

*For grant of adequate protection to the petitioner who is
complainant in the FIR,*

*Seeking action against the jail officials who are
instrumental in letting convict Bikramjit Singh Operate a*

*Drug Racket in jail,
Directing the respondent No.2 to arrest proclaimed offender
Surjit Singh who is openly roaming around in the Village.”*

Mr. Yatinder Sharma, Addl. A.G. Punjab submits that challan in the FIR No.128 under Sections 222, 223, 224 IPC registered at Civil Lines, Amritsar City has already been filed against respondent No.9. Case is almost at the final stage.

As regards the plea qua security, security has already been provided to the petitioner and another accused whom the petitioner is asking for arrest has already been declared as proclaimed offender.

In view of aforementioned observations, no further action is required.

Accordingly, present writ petition stands disposed of.
