On 03.03.2017, this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR No.88 dated 21.09.2015, has been registered under Sections 366/506/120-B IPC, at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga, at her instance against respondent No.4 but even after the passage of about one and a half years, no report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the official respondents. He further submits that he would be satisfied if a direction be issued to the official respondents to file the report at the earliest after conclusion of their investigation.

Notice of motion at this stage be issued to respondents No.1 to 3 for 07.03.2017.

Mr. Neeraj Yadav, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply four copies of the petition to Mr. Yadav, during the course of the day.”

A perusal of the afore-quoted order shows that learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the official respondents to conclude at the earliest the investigation in FIR No. 88, dated 21.09.2015, under Sections 366, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, learned State counsel submits that in the case in hand the afore-referred FIR has been investigated and a cancellation report dated 16.03.2016 has been prepared.

However, the same has not been filed before the competent court.

In view of the fact that the cancellation report had been prepared about a year ago with no explanation coming forth from the side of the State as to why the filing of the same has been delayed, I deem it proper to direct the State to take a final decision on the cancellation report prepared on 16.03.2016 within 15 days from today.

The above direction satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Disposed of in the above terms.
