Reply filed by respondent No.5 is taken on record.

Heard Mr. Robert Kanwar, Advocate for the petitioner and
the learned State counsel.

It is not in dispute and is apparent from the reply filed by the
State that recovery of dead body itself was made from the well after six
months. Obviously the investigating machinery would not be in a
position to ascertain any cause of death. Though it is unfortunate for the
petitioner-wife that she has lost her husband, the circumstances are such
that no effective orders can be passed.

Learned State counsel submits that the cancellation report
has been prepared. The police is at liberty to take such steps according to
law.

In the light of the above factual scenario, in the result, the petition is disposed of on the basis of the affidavit filed by Rajinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rajpura dated 26.02.2016.
