In the instant writ petition, petitioner has questioned the order dated 29.8.2011 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.1-Authority under the Payment of Wages Act, 1936 vide which the Authority allowed the respondent-workman's application in respect of wages. The petitioner had statutory remedy of appeal before the Appellate Authority. Without exhausting the remedy of appeal, petitioner has rushed to this Court. On the ground of alternative remedy, writ petition stands dismissed.

Liberty to file appeal is permitted to the petitioner provided if the appeal is filed before the Appellate Authority within one month from today after due compliance to the concerned provision relating to appeal. Leaving open the issue of delay in filing appeal.
