Learned counsel for the petitioner presses the present petition on the quantum of sentence only. Custody certificate dated 10.10.2017 filed in Court is taken on record. It shows that the petitioner has undergone the total sentence of 6 months and 17 days, including remission of 25 days. In this case, cheque was of Rs.1,85,000/-. As per custody certificate, petitioner is not the previous convict nor any other case is pending against him.

Considering all the facts and circumstances, substantive sentence of rigorous imprisonment for one year is hereby reduced to rigorous imprisonment for nine months. Remaining part of sentence is maintained.

With the above mentioned modification, the revision stands dismissed.
