The petitioner had been relegated to avail the alternative remedy by approaching the Civil Court vide order dated 05.10.2012 but after the death of respondent No.5 Pritpal Kaur on 09.11.2012, a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-15861-2013 had revived the present petition and directed the same to be fixed for hearing along with CWP-15861-2013.

Since order dated 05.10.2012 relegating the petitioner to alternative remedy of Civil Court, has been recalled and a fresh petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming her rights on the basis of documents i.e. official letter dated 23.02.2012 which is part of the other petition as Annexure P-18 and all the pleas taken up in this petition having been raised

in the subsequent petition, this petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to be determined in the other writ petition.
