1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

In pursuance to the notice issued by this Court, Mr. Parveen Setia, Manager, on behalf of respondent No. 1-Bank has appeared. He has stated that the accounts of revisionist have been settled and the claim of respondent-Bank has been satisfied. He has already issued no dues certificate. He has also confirmed the correctness of No Dues Certificate dated 16.8.2017 (Annexure-P-2).

Since the accounts of revisionist have been settled with respondent No. 1-Bank, the learned counsel for revisionist confines his prayer only on the quantum of sentence.

As revisionist has paid the entire cheque amount and other amounts, the sentence of revisionist is reduced to the period already undergone by him. He be released forthwith, if not required in any other case.

In view of the matter, present revision is disposed of.
