

Since the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, demand draft No. 013268, dated 19.8.2017, for Rs. 2,00,000/-, in favour of respondent No. 2-complainant Ravinder, lying with Registrar (Judicial) of this Court be released to respondent No. 2-complainant against proper receipt. Today, another sum of Rs. 25,000/- in cash has been handed over to respondent No. 2-complainant in the Court itself.

CRR No. 2904 of 2017 (O/M)

It being so, the matter has been lawfully compounded. In view of the attitude of the parties in compounding the offence, the cost of 15%, as per authority of the Apex Court in Damodar S. Prabhu Versus Sayed Babalal H., 2010 (5) SCC 663, is waived off.

Since the matter has been lawfully compounded, revisionist stands acquitted of the notice of accusation, served upon him. The judgment of conviction dated 3.12.2016 and order of sentence dated 5.12.2016, passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurgaon (now Gurugram), as well as the judgment dated 9.8.2017, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, are hereby set aside. Bail bond and surety bond of revisionist stand discharged.

In view of the above, revision is allowed.
