By filing the present petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to respondent No.1 to grant parole for care of family and home under the Punjab Parole Act, 1962.

Heard.

The petitioner is seeking parole in FIR No. 124 dated 01.12.2008, registered under Section 302 of IPC, at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda, whereby he was convicted and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment. The petitioner submitted an application seeking parole for four weeks to Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda. Thereafter, his case was sent for police report to the District Magistrate, PS Jarwal Road, District Behrich. The District Magistrate, Behrich, vide letter dated 14.03.2016 has expressed that there is a possibility of breach of peace in

the State in case the parole is allowed to the petitioner.

Therefore, keeping in view the above, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the present petition since the release of the petitioner on parole is likely to endanger the security of the State or the maintenance of public order.

Dismissed.
