This criminal writ petition filed by the petitioner was prima-facie held to be a frivolous one vide order dated 05.04.2016 passed by the Coordinate Bench. Thereafter, directions were issued to the petitioner to remain present in Court for which even bailable warrants were issued against him. Presence of the petitioner could not be secured despite issuance of non-bailable warrants. Even the Senior Superintendent of Police was directed to be present in Court for ascertaining the efforts made by the police to nab the petitioner. Raid was conducted on the address of the petitioner, but his house was found locked as whereabouts could not be ascertained. The efforts are still being made to locate the

petitioner.

In view of facts and circumstances of the case, this case cannot be adjourned repeatedly for the same purpose.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mohammad Rashid submitted that efforts are still being made to secure presence of the petitioner.

In view of aforesaid, this petition is disposed of. However, liberty is granted to the police to get it revived as and when the petitioner is arrested.
