After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file fresh one, if necessity arises. He further submits that vide order dated 02.06.2017, passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Ropar, the parties have been directed to appear before the learned Trial Court, whereas the petitioners have not been summoned under Section 319 of Code of Criminal Procedure.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty. It is also observed that the present petitioners, who have not yet been summoned under Section 319 of Code of Criminal Procedure, need not to appear before the learned trial Court unless otherwise summoned.
