Application is allowed as prayed for.

The photocopy of the demand draft (Annexure A-1) and receipt dated 20.09.2017 (Annexure A-2) are taken on record.

Main case

In terms of the last order dated 07.09.2017, the petitioner has deposited a demand draft bearing No.543604, dated 16.09.2017, amounting to ₹35,000/- in favour of the Legal Service Committee of this Court being 10% of the cheque amount.

Heard.

It comes out from the order dated 07.09.2017 passed by this Court that the parties have compromised the matter vide compromise deed dated 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-1). The complainant has received the entire cheque amount and he has no objection if the present revision petition is

allowed and the judgments passed by both the courts below are set aside and the petitioner is acquitted of the notice of accusation served upon her.

Since, the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 has been lawfully compounded and the litigation expenses have also been deposited with the Legal Services committee of this Court, therefore, the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 18.05.2016 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Hansi as well as the judgment dated 29.08.2017 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Hisar are hereby set aside and the petitioner is acquitted of the notice of accusation served upon her and her bail bonds and surety bonds also stand discharged.

As such, the present revision petition is allowed.
