Revisionist alongwith other co-accused is stated to have hired a Tata ACE for carrying buffalo. In the way, they asked the driver to get down to see the way and when he alighted, they sped away with said vehicle.

As per the custody certificate, revisionist has already undergone total sentence of 4 months and 14 days, including remission of one month. He is facing another case under Section 457 IPC read with Section 511 IPC.

Considering the fact that maximum sentence for offence is simple imprisonment for 6 months, there is no ground to reduce the same. Hence, revision is dismissed.
