During course of trial, petitioner made a confessional statement on 05.10.2015 to the effect that he had issued a cheque in question to the complainant in order to discharge his legal liability. Petitioner also admitted issuance of legal notice by the complainant. He also undertook that he will make the payment of cheque amount i.e. Rs.4,50,000/- on or before the next date before the trial Court, failing which his statement be read as confessional statement and in that eventuality, he will not claim any defence and he be punished accordingly.

Having admitted the liability to pay the amount to the complainant and having not done so, in my considered opinion, petitioner does not deserve any indulgence by this Court.
