After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, I am of the opinion that the pleas which had been raised before the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services) could have either been taken up in the civil suit filed by the petitioners or in case, the petitioners wanted to split the remedies, the appropriate forum was the Registrar under the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012. It has been informed that the alternative remedy has already been availed of by the petitioners.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to

pursue the alternative remedy which has already been taken up.

This petition is disposed of as withdrawn observing that dismissal of the application by the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services) or disposed of this writ petition will not in any manner obstruct the enforcement of right of the petitioners before the appropriate forum.
