KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Status report dated 18.09.2017 on behalf of the State has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel contends that regarding disappearance of Arshad, FIR No.525, dated 29.12.2014 has been registered at Police Station Mandi, District Saharanpur, where the investigation is being carried out. The cancellation report has been submitted on 13.03.2015. Therefore, Punjab Police cannot do anything in the matter.

It is further stated that the complainant and his wife are not cooperating in conducting the investigation. Only the wife of complainant knows, where the child has gone.

After examining the matter, I am of the view that since FIR has already been registered at Police Station Mandi, District Saharanpur and the matter is being investigated, it is for the Saharanpur police to take necessary action in the matter and the present complaint, which has been received

through post and has been treated as complaint, stands disposed of, accordingly.
