There is delay of 14 days in filing the present revision petition.

Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioner presses the present revision petition only on the point of quantum of sentence.

Heard.

The petitioner is stated to have obtained a loan amounting to ₹15,10,500/- from the complainant-bank. In order to repay the over due amount of the loan, the petitioner issued a cheque bearing No.651122, dated 19.03.2014, amounting to ₹7,50,000/-, which was dishonoured for want of sufficient funds.

Considering the amount of ₹7,50,000/- for which cheque was issued, I am of the view that the sentence of simple imprisonment awarded to the petitioner by the lower court cannot be called on higher side.

As such, the present revision petition is dismissed.
