SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present revision petition has been filed against order dated 5.9.2017, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani, whereby application for bail of the petitioner was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is a juvenile in conflict with law and on the date of alleged occurrence, he was juvenile. The other juvenile in conflict with law, namely; Deepak @ Nikku was released on bail as per order of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani on 11.10.2017 and the case of the petitioner is identical to him and on parity, he be released on bail. More so, father of the petitioner is also ready to furnish the bond that he would take care of his son under his control and look after him and his son will not come in association with any known criminal.

Learned State counsel submitted that if father of the petitioner is ready to furnish the bond so as to undertake the behaviour of his son in

the future and undertaking that his son will not come in association with bad elements, the State has no objection as the petitioner is juvenile in conflict with law and is in custody from 16.5.2017.

Having considered these facts, the present revision petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of :-

1. appropriate bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Magistrate;
2. an affidavit by way of undertaking by father of the petitioner and natural guardian that his son (petitioner) would keep good behaviour under his supervision and he shall not come in contact with bad elements so as to commit any offence in future as well.

The present petition stands disposed of.
