JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of the instant Civil Writ Petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the direction in the nature of Mandamus to the respondents for release of retiral benefits i.e. Pension, Gratuity and Provident Fund, which have been illegally withheld by respondents along with interest @ 12% on delayed payments.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that retiral benefits have already been paid to the petitioner but not within a prescribed period and there is a delay in making the payment thereof.

3. With regard to relief grant of Pension, Gratuity and Provident Fund etc. instant petition has rendered infructuous. It stands disposed of as such. However, respondent No.2 is directed to consider the claim regarding payment of interest on the delayed payments within a period of three months' and in case, claim of the petitioner with regard to interest is found genuine and valid, to make payment thereof within a reasonable period.
