Custody certificate filed in Court today and same is taken on record. Revision has been pressed on the quantum of sentence only.

As per the custody certificate dated 2.10.2017, revisionist has already undergone total sentence of 5 months and 20 days, including remission. Revisionist is not a previous convict nor any case is pending against him.

Considering the entirety of facts and circumstances, the substantive sentence of rigorous imprisonment for one year, awarded under Section 411 IPC, is hereby reduced to rigorous imprisonment for nine months.

With the abovenoted modification, revision is dismissed.
