The petitioner has approached this Court seeking following relief:-

“For issuance of direction to the respondent Nos.1 to 3 to deliver the possession of land to the petitioner in time bound manner in pursuance of the partition order dated 08.07.2013 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Narwana.”

The petition is bereft of the proceedings after the passing of the order dated 25.11.2014 (Annexure P-4) vis-a-vis the relief sought in the writ petition. Until and unless proceedings are not attached, this Court cannot pass the order. Even otherwise, order of the partition is executable under Section 123 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act. Once process has already been initiated, the petitioner has a liberty to pursue the remedy in pursuance

to the letter of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Narwana written to the Naib Tehsildar, Narwana.

In view of aforementioned, present writ petition stands disposed of.
