Prayer in the present writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* or mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction to respondent No.3 for framing a suitable policy to grant permission to practice as Notaries to sit outside the premises of three Courts, namely, Estate Office, SDM. (East) and SDM (South) functioning under the control of respondent No.3 and granting interim relief to the petitioner as prayed for.

In compliance to the order dated 02.02.2017, an affidavit of Ajit Balaji Joshi, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Union Territory, Chandigarh has been filed in Court today, indicating the fact that as per the undertaking given to the Court, the petitioner has been granted permission to sit in the Estate Officer Premises, Sector 17, vide letter dated 14.02.2017 (Annexure A-1) and the petitioner, in pursuance to the aforementioned letter,

has also deposited the requisite fee and given an undertaking, whereas allotment and possession of seat No.2 has been allotted.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, the grievance of the petitioner stands vindicated and no further orders are required to pass in the present writ petition.

Resultantly, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
