

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that as the matter in controversy is regarding some payment and issuance of cheque, the entire payment has been made to the respondent and the parties have settled their claim. Otherwise, learned counsel for the respondent affirms the factum of compromise and receipt of payment of entire amount by the respondent.

As per provision of Section 147 of N.I. Act, the offences under this Act are compoundable, which is extracted here below:-

“Offences to be compoundable-

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), every offence punishable under this Act shall be compoundable.”

In view of the above, the necessary permission is granted to compound the offence and present revision petition is accepted and judgment of conviction and order of sentence recorded by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class dated 23.01.2015 and judgment passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge dated 12.09.2017 are hereby set aside.

Present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
