This revision is directed against the order dated 23.08.2017 passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Sirsa vide which the application filed by the accused/petitioner for sending the cheque No.23248 and cheque No. 23247 relating to another complaint titled as “Daya Ram vs. Gurnam Singh” to FSL for comparing the writing made on the body of the cheques, was dismissed.

It is contended that both the cheques are forged and fabricated and to prove this fact, the petitioner has moved the instant application which has been wrongly dismissed by the learned Magistrate.

Heard.

It has been observed by the learned Magistrate that the version of the accused is not that he wants to get examined his signatures on the cheques from CFSL/handwriting expert. In fact, the

petitioner wants to get examined the writing made in the body of the cheque.

The Court feels that once the signatures on the cheques are admitted by the petitioner, no case for sending the cheques to CFSL for comparison of handwriting on the body of the cheques is made out inasmuch as the body of the cheque can be filled by any authorised person.

In view of above, the revision petition is meritless and the same is, therefore, dismissed.
