Learned counsel for the petitioner presses the revision only on the quantum of sentence.

Custody certificate dated 22.11.2017 filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. It shows that the petitioner has undergone the actual sentence of 4 months and 21 days. Maximum sentence awarded is Rigorous Imprisonment for one year.

Taking into consideration the fact that daily more than 400 people die in road accidents and 2-3 times are injure, the offences relating to the death in the motor vehicular accidents are to be dealt with strenuously. Therefore, I do not find any ground to reduce the sentence.

Consequently, the present petition stands dismissed.
