Since the petitioner seeks re-constitution of the partnership firm by substituting his wife in place of other partner regarding which a reply to the show cause notice dated 14.12.2012 had been submitted vide Annexure P-23, dated 29.12.2012 and no decision having been taken by the Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., a direction is issued that the reply, Annexure P-23, be considered by passing the speaking order, after hearing the petitioner or any of the representative of the petitioner, within a period of three months. In case, any adverse order is passed against the petitioner while considering the reply to the show cause notice dated 14.12.2012, the same will not be implemented for a period of one month after communication of the same to

the petitioner to enable the petitioner to take appropriate legal remedy, if so desired.

Petition is disposed of with the abovesaid directions.
