1. Learned counsel for the respondents files an additional reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Pawan Kumar Panchal, Executive Engineer S&D HVPNL Dhulkote, Ambala, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3. The same is taken on record.

2. In the affidavit, it was admitted that petitioner is senior and his juniors' services have been regularized. In view of statement made in the affidavit, petitioner is entitled for regularization w.e.f. date from his juniors' services were regularized. Accordingly, order dated 10.04.2015 (Annexure P/5) is hereby set aside. Consequently, respondents are directed to re-examine petitioner's case on par with his juniors whose services have been regularized and to regularise his services from the date of his juniors. The above exercise shall be completed within a period of three months.

Petitioner is also entitled for monetary benefits during intervening period from the date of regularization till passing of order. Arrears of pay be calculated and released within a period of three months.

3. Accordingly, instant writ petition stands allowed.
