KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondent-bank has produced the certificate dated 07.12.2017 showing that the petitioner has compromised with the respondent-bank and agreed amount has been deposited with the bank. Now, the bank does not want to pursue the present case. The said certificate is taken on record.

In view of the compromise effected between the parties the judgment dated 31.08.2017 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Kaithal and the judgment of conviction dated 26.07.2017 and order of sentence dated 28.07.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kaithal, convicting and sentencing the petitioner for the commission of offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, are hereby set aside. The petitioner is acquitted of the notice of accusation served upon him. His bail bonds and surety bonds stand discharged.

As such, the present revision petition is allowed.
