Petitioner seeks action against respondents No.3 & 4. He alleges that all the injuries were not brought on record by the said doctors at the time MLR of the injured was conducted on 30.3.2016.

Stand of the State is that all injuries, which were found on the person of injured, were entered in the record. A medical board was also constituted. Another four injuries were added, which were in the nature of contusions. As the case appears to be of version and cross-version, the entire issue can be considered by the trial court at the relevant stage. As regards role of the doctors, it is left to the Chief Medical Officer, Mansa to examine the same at his level. No further direction in writ jurisdiction is necessary, as disputed questions of fact are involved.
