Heard on the point of quantum of sentence.

Custody certificate filed in the Court today is taken on record.

It shows that the petitioner has undergone total sentence of 1 month 14 days including remission of 4 days. No other case is pending or decided against him.

The crime committed in the present case is theft of motorcycle.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the substantive sentence of rigorous imprisonment for one year awarded to the petitioner by both the courts below is reduced to rigorous imprisonment for 9 months. However, the remaining part of the sentence is maintained.

With the abovenoted modification, the present revision petition is dismissed.
