During the pendency of the writ petition, Annexure R/2 dated 31.07.1987 has been annexed, which according to the respondent(s) had been decided in pursuance to the order dated 23.01.1986 (Annexure P-1).

The remedy, if any, for the petitioner is to challenge the same by filing an appeal under the Punjab Land Reforms Act and not seeking a *mandamus* as the relief sought in the present writ petition was only to issue a direction to the respondent(s) to decide.
