Power of Attorney on behalf of the appellants has been filed today by Mr.Virendra Rana, Advocate.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹2,15,000/- (₹ Two Lac Fifteen Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1 – Smt.Lichhama Devi widow of Shri Chhabil Das.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed – cheque for ₹2,15,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 – Smt.Lichhama Devi widow of Shri Chhabil Das with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 21.08.2017, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.
