Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is to the notification dated 07.01.2016 issued by the Government of Punjab in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 30(2)(a) of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, whereby manufacture, storage, distribution or sale of any articles of food, having tobacco and nicotine as its ingredients, has been prohibited for one year in the State of Punjab.

A perusal of the aforesaid notification shows that the prohibition was imposed for a period of one year. The said period of one

year has already expired. As such, the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
