Heard.

Custody certificate filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

Allegations against revisionist are that he alongwith one Deepak was riding a stolen motorcycle having fake number plate. One country made pistol was recovered from Deepak and forged RC of said motorcycle was recovered from the possession of Vikas Sharma (revisionist), who was riding the pillion.

The learned counsel for revisionist has stated that out of two FIRs against revisionist, in one case, revisionist was discharged and in another case, he has been acquitted. Therefore, there is no other case pending against him.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the sentences of rigorous imprisonment for one year each, awarded under

CRR No. 4011 of 2017 (O/M)

Sections 471, 474 IPC, is reduced to rigorous imprisonment for six months each. The sentence awarded under Section 411 IPC and the sentence of fine is maintained.

With the abovenoted modification in sentence, revision is dismissed.
