Both the parties have produced on record a compromise dated 8.11.2017 (Annexure P1). Respondent has appeared in person and has produced on record a copy of his Adhar Card to prove his identity. It is stated in the compromise that the complainant has received the entire cheque amount of Rs.four lakhs. He has no objection if the petitioner is acquitted of the notice of accusation served upon him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is not in a position to pay composition fee to the Legal Service Committee of this Court and prays that sentence of the petitioner be reduced to the period already undergone by him.

Considering the fact that the parties have compromised the matter, judgment of conviction dated 12.4.2016 and order of sentence dated 21.4.2016 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Faridabad and

judgment dated 26.10.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad are hereby modified on the quantum of sentence to the extent that the petitioner is sentenced to the period already undergone by him under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Petitioner be released forthwith, if not required in any other case.

With the above noted modification, the revision petition is dismissed.
