Custody certificate of the petitioner has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

In this case, notice was issued only on the point of quantum of sentence.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he was found in possession of 120 bottles of licit liquor.

As per custody certificate, the petitioner has already undergone actual sentence of 9 months, 6 days including remission of 1 month 15 days. It also shows that the petitioner is not a previous convict nor any other case is pending against him.

Considering the fact that it is the first offence committed by the petitioner, the substantive sentence of rigorous imprisonment for one year awarded to the petitioner by both the court below is reduced to the period already undergone by him i.e. 9 months and 6 days.

With the abovenoted modification, the present revision petition is dismissed.

The petitioner be released forthwith, if not required in any other case.
