Present petition has been filed by an association of Multi Purpose Health Workers (Female). They have prayed for a direction that members of the association be granted registration for purpose of practicing as Nurses Midwives, Multi Workers, Health Workers etc.

At the outset, learned counsel for the Nurses Registration Council (respondents No.3 & 4 herein) submit that in case individual applications are submitted by members of the association, same would be considered as per law.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. The writ petition is hereby disposed of. It is made clear that as and when an application is received from the members of the association, decision thereon shall be taken by the Council, in any case not later than one month of receipt of such application.
