Revision was pressed only on the quantum of sentence.

Custody certificate filed in Court today and same is taken on record which shows that revisionist has already undergone total sentence of 4 months and 3 days, including remission of 5 days.

Revisionist was convicted by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ropar, under Sections 279, 304-A, 427 IPC, vide judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 11.4.2016 and was sentenced as under :-

Under Section 279 IPC	To undergo RI for the Period of Three Months and to pay Fine of Rs. 500/-, and in default of payment of fine to further undergo S.I. for Ten Days.
Under Section 304-A IPC	To undergo RI for the Period of One Year and to pay Fine of Rs. 1000/-, and in default of payment of fine to further undergo S.I. for 15 Days.

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Under Section 427 IPC

To undergo RI for the Period of Six
Months.

All sentences were directed to run concurrently. The appeal was dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, vide judgment dated 21.8.2017.

The perusal of judgments of both the Courts below shows that revisionist while driving the bus hit activa scooter of Jiya Lal from backside and dragged it to some distance. Thereafter, revisionist fled away from the spot alongwith bus.

Considering that one persons lost his life and revisionist did not care to help the injured and fled away from the spot, there is no ground to reduce the sentence awarded by two Courts below. Hence, revision is dismissed.
