Petitioner-Sonia Sharma has competed for appointment against the post of Hindi Mistress in the General Category pursuant to 3442 posts of Masters/Mistresses advertised on 07.05.2011.

As per the written statement, the cut off merit in the General Category was 54.216, whereas the ascertained merit of the petitioner as per the prescribed criteria is 53.48, thus, the petitioner did not fall within the zone of appointment.

Grievance of the petitioner was that she had passed additional subject of Hindi in Graduation with better marks and, therefore, she should be assigned additional marks as per the selection criteria so as to enhance her merit.

At the time of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition as in the subsequent selection, the petitioner stands appointed as a Teacher.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
