By this common order, both the aforementioned writ petitions shall be decided together as issue is identical. Facts are taken from CWP No.14977 of 2013.

In terms of the order dated 25.4.2017 read with communication of the State dated 26.4.2017 addressed to the Registrar, Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak, the petitioners have been extended the benefit of revised pay scale w.e.f. 8.3.2011.

In view of the said development, petition do not survive for consideration. However, it is made clear that the petitioners are entitled for difference of pay from 8.3.2011 till payment is made. The same shall be calculated and disburse to the petitioners within a period of three months from today.

With the above observation, petition stands disposed of.

Reserving liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 25.4.2017 read with communication dated 26.4.2017, if they are still aggrieved.
