Inspector, himself appeared and supported the prosecution case.

The defence of the accused is that he is not the owner of the shop.

I am of the view that there is nothing illegal in the findings recorded by both the Courts below. The possession of desi ghee is material and not the ownership of shop. It is the quality and not the quantity of evidence which is to be seen. Therefore, the lower Court rightly believed the statement of Shri K.K. Sharma, Government Food Inspector, without corroboration from any other witnesses. There is a report of Public Analyst regarding the desi ghee being found adulterated. Since the sentence imposed on revisionist is already minimum punishment, prescribed under the law, therefore, no interference is called for in the sentence. Hence, revision is dismissed.
