Heard.

Custody certificate filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

Notice of motion was issued only on the quantum of sentence.

Revisionist was found carrying a bag on his shoulder. On search of bag, a plastic cane, containing 39 bottles of 750 ML and one bottle of 570 ML of illicit liquor was found. The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala, convicted the revisionist under Section 61 (1) (a) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, and awarded rigorous imprisonment for one year and to pay fine of Rs. 500/-, in default of payment of fine, to further undergo rigorous imprisonment two months, vide judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 9.2.2017. The sentence was upheld in appeal.

The perusal of custody certificate shows that revisionist is facing two more cases under the Excise Act.

Keeping in view the background of revisionist, there is no ground to reduce the sentence. Hence, revision is dismissed.
